### **1. Roll Call:**

Posting and advertising of this meeting was done in compliance with Utah's Open Meetings Act and State budget requirements. Trustee Vickers called the meeting to order at 6:04 p.m., and no conflicts of interest were declared.

### **2. 2021 General Fund and Capital Project Fund Budget Amendments Hearing:**

CFO Fairbanks explained the reasoning behind the proposed line-item amendments to the 2021 Budgets. The Board was satisfied with the explanations and felt the modifications were justified.

**3. 2021 Certified Tax Rate Hearing:**

The Utah State Tax Commission had not yet finalized the 2021 Certified Tax Rate, but the preliminary data establishes a certified tax rate of 0.000115, providing \$3,736,002. It is 0.000007 lower than 2020's Certified Tax Rate of 0.000122.

CFO Fairbanks reviewed the proposed 2022 Budget with the Board. Upon noticing a data entry error, she left the meeting briefly to correct the error and returned with the corrected budgets.

**4. Public Comments:**


There were no public comments about the 2021 Budget Amendments, the 2021 Certified Tax Rate, or the 2022 Budget Proposals.

**5. Adjournment:**

The Public Hearing was adjourned at 6:36 p.m. when Trustee Liddle made a motion to close the 2021 Budget Amendments and Certified Tax Rate Hearing. Trustee Turner seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.
